

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the C116 Hale Road from its junction with the C126 School Road to a point 285 metres east of its junction with the U33234 Halfmile Drift in the PARISH OF BRADENHAM because of tree trimming works around BT cables.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) between 09:30 and 15:30 hours on 29th January 2021 for the duration of the works, expected to be 6 hours within the period.

Alternative route is via: C116 Bradenham Road/ Station Road, C117 Hale Road, C117/ C768 Watton Road, C768 Road From Saham Toney To Ashill/ Richmond Road/ Swaffham Road, B1108 Brandon Road/ High Street, A1075 Cadman Way/ Dereham Road/ Watton Road (Ashill, Bradenham, Ovington, Holme Hale, Saham Toney, Shipdham, Watton).


(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
