

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the U33283 Manor Road from its junction with the U33236 Squires Oak Lane to a point 627 metres east of its junction with the U33234 Halfmile Drift in the PARISH OF BRADENHAM because of BT pole testing works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) between 09:30 and 15:30 hours on 13<sup>th</sup> January 2021 for the duration of the works, expected to be 6 hours within the period.

Alternative route is via: U33283 Manor Road, U33234 West End, U33236 Squires Oak Lane and vice versa.


(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

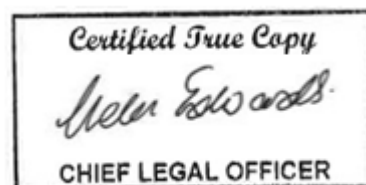

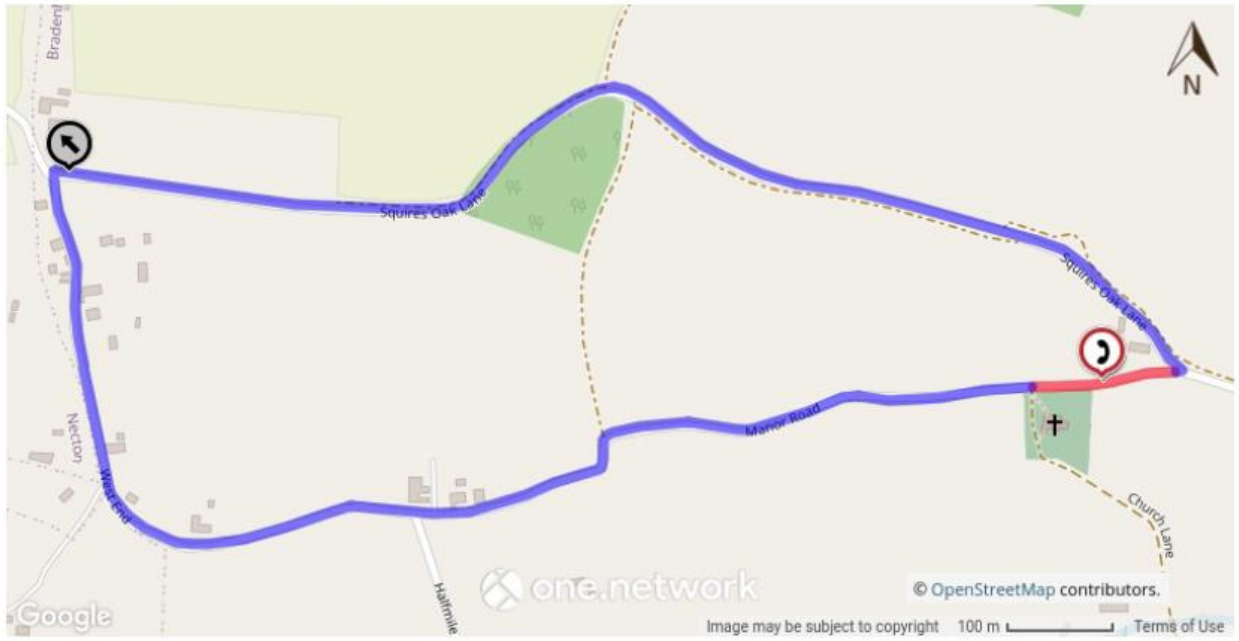
